PrimeTime COVID-19 Amendment Valdosta YMCA





YMCA Policies

These policies may be revised but will remain in-line with the school policies.

Staff Protocol:

- All Staff are required to adhere to a clean facility. This means doing their part in spot checking, sanitizing, and wiping down all equipment, counters, tablets, and furniture used every half hour to the hour. A clean facility is everybody's responsibility
- Staff are required to have their temperature taken immediately upon entering the facility
- Temperature and health screening question responses will be logged on a log sheet.
- Temp. must be below 100.4
- If someone comes in from the heat, they will be allowed to take 5 min. to cool down before taking their temp. They will be asked wait outside or away from others while doing so.
- All staff are required to wear a face mask during their shift.

Sanitizing and Hand Washing:

- High touch areas (i.e. tables tops, door handles) will be sanitized before, during and at the end of the program by using EPA approved sanitizers.
- All Staff are required to sanitize all activity areas after their group has used it.
- Children and Staff will be required to wash or sanitize their hands:
 - At Check In
 - Before and after activities
 - Before and after eating snack/dinner

Social Distancing Policy:

- Participants will be advised to keep 6ft of distance between themselves and other campers. Maintaining at least an arm's length distance.
- Groups must always have a 6ft distance between them.
- Children may wear face masks.
- Children's belonging should be kept in their backpacks.
- Each participant should bring their own water bottle labeled with their name on it. They will only be allowed to fill water bottles at water fountains.





- Signage will be posted to help participants have a visual of safe distancing.
 - Arm's length spacing at tables
 - Number of tiles on the floor between each person when they line up
 - Physical makers showing personal boundaries for games and programs.

Temperature Checks:

- We will be conducting Temp. Checks two times daily for staff and children.
 - Check in
 - Check out
- Temperatures will be written on the Temp. Log during temp. check.
- Temp. Logs will be turned into the Director to review and address any issues.
- If at any point the participant has a temperature over **100.4**, they will be isolated, and the parents called. Child must be picked up within **30 minutes**.
- If a staff member has a temperature or displays any symptoms during the program, they will immediately be sent home.

Child or Staff Re-Admittance:

- Children or Staff must present one of the following before being re-admitted to the program:
 - Negative COVID Test
 - Fever and fever mediation free for 72 hours and NO symptoms for 10 Days

Isolation policy:

- If at any point throughout the program a participant starts to present symptoms, the Site Leader will be notified, and the child sent to the designated isolation area. (Symptoms: Fever, Chills, Repeated shaking with chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, New loss of taste or smell)
- The child's parents or guardians will be called to come pick up their child within 30 minutes

Positive COVID Policy:

- Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 °F or higher, known exposure to COVID-19 or who has tested positive for COVID-19 will do the following before returning to the YMCA:
 - o Staff:
 - Inform supervisor
 - Participant
 - Notify the YMCA Child Care Director at 244-4646
- Go get screened to be tested for COVID-19



- Go home and self-isolate for 14 days or until a negative result from COVID-19 test
- Be re-tested before returning

Arrival at PrimeTime:

- Temp checks (with non-touch infrared thermometers) and health screening questions will be conducted before each child enters the licensed area.
- Staff will sign in participants using a tablet.
- Children will sanitize their hands and be sent to their assigned group.
- Participants must always be with their group.

Pick up: Text ahead to site cell phone (see Parent Handbook)

- Parent will text their child's site phone approximately 5-10 minutes prior to pickup:
 - Child's Name and Grade
- Upon arrival at school, Parent will come to the door to the program and show their ID.
- Staff will verify ID to authorized pick up list and call for child.
- Staff will use a non-touch infrared thermometer to document child's temperature prior to dismissal.
- Staff will sign out child using a tablet.

Programming and Activities:

- Participants will complete all games and activities with their group.
- Participants may not switch groups throughout the day.

Activities:

- Children's hands will be washed before and after each activity.
- Children must always maintain arm's length distance between each other.
- Counselor will sanitize the activity area after that activity is finished according to the activity cleaning quidelines.
- All crafts and STEM activities will be pre bagged for each small group with the supplies that they will need.

Games:





- We will be programming games that minimize close contact. (Sports drills, movement relay, minute to win it, etc.)
- Participant's hands will be washed before and after each game.
- Counselors will disinfect equipment that is used after each group.
